2018 BENALLA FESTIVAL WRITING COMPETITION

As part of the 2018 Benalla Festival, budding writers in Benalla Rural City are invited to enter a poem or a piece of writing on the topic 'Our Backyard' This topic is based on this year's Benalla Festival theme which celebrates special places and spaces in our community. Be creative - about the things you love about your own backyard. The possibilities are almost limitless! Your piece might be:

- Benalla's famous 'rocket' in the Botanical Gardens do you remember climbing it?
- The walking track around the lake and the large fig tree on Casey's Island
- A favourite swimming hole
- Your favourite room at school or favourite place in the playground
- The place where you met the love of your life
- Your favourite eating place or shop in Benalla
- Your favourite rural space
- Where I go to be alone when I'm feeling blue
- Your garden in springtime
- Bridge Street at Christmas time
- A day's water skiing at Lake Nillahcootie
- A bike ride around the Winton Wetlands

Rules and Conditions

- 1. Entry is **free** and participants can have a maximum of two entries. The pieces of writing can vary in style (biographical, expository, discursive or narrative).
- 2. Entries close on Monday 22 October 2018 at 5pm and can be submitted:
 - in person at the Benalla Rural City Council's Customer Service Centre; or
 - at the Sir Edward 'Weary' Dunlop Learning Centre (Benalla Library), Fawckner Drive, Benalla; or
 - posted to Benalla Rural City Council, PO Box 227 Benalla 3671 with 'Writing Competition' clearly marked on the outside of the envelope.
- 3. There will be six different categories for you to enter:
 - Grade 3/4 (word limit of 200 words)
 Year 9/10 (word limit of 500 words)
 - Grade 5/6 (word limit of 300 words). Year 7/8 (word limit of 400 words)
- Year 11/12 (word limit of 600 words)
- Open (word limit of 800 words)
- 4. The piece of writing must be the entrant's own work and not have been previously published.
- 5. Entries must be typed and on A4 paper. The information below must be attached to the entry.
- 6. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence entered into.
- 7. Staff members of Benalla Rural City Council and members of the Benalla Festival Advisory Committee are not permitted to enter the competition.
- 8. Winners, runners up and encouragement award recipients of the six categories will be notified by telephone on
- Friday 26 October and asked to attend a presentation on the evening of Thursday 8 November 2018.
